**Master Action Plan (MAP) and Experiences Sharing by Participants of Pakistan Leadership Initiative (PELI) 2011**

### CONTEXT

---

The participants of the programme will share the learning experience of PELI 2011 with IPL/ITA and their Head of Departments.

**Key points discussed in the meeting**

---

**Dr. Baela Raza Jamil (ITA/IPL)** opened the meeting by welcoming back the PELI Participants and explained that this is the first time that Plymouth State University has offered 15 credit hours after the successful completion of the course. The negotiations are going on with the PSU to extend these 15 credit hours to 36 credit hours to take this to a Masters course, so that the participant will get a degree rather than a certificate. The rest of the course will be completed in Pakistan and Insha Allah IPL will host this programme.

**Mr. Abdul Jawad (DSD)** talked about the long term partnership of DSD with ITA, he was quite pleased with the programme, credit hours attached to it and its practical implementation in Pakistan.

**Miss Sania Rauf (WWF)** shared her experiences regarding inter & intra national interaction, networking & future associations, reconsideration of set perceptions, foreign education system observation, foreign faculty, exposure of American society along with her Master Action Plan. Topic of her MAP is energy conservation (significance of using alternate energy). She will conduct with 30 students of grade viii in duration of three days session of 2 hours each day.

**Ms Arshia Khurshid (PEF)** explained about the activities during the visit, she talked about museum visit, Voice of America interview, State Department visit. Her Master Action Plan was regarding Activity based Lesson Planning for the cluster schools of Punjab Education Foundation in rural areas of Bahawalpur region. Her main focus was on use of low cost and no cost material as she will be implementing her plan in the deprived area. Her master action plan was commented as the most detailed and well structured plan.

**Farzana Kousar (Sanjan Nagar Higher Secondary school)** discussed about different speakers and their sessions held during the programme i.e. wordless books, qualities of good leaders, explore environment education model. She also talked about the places visited during Washington stay. She liked the community library idea and wish that it could be replicated in Pakistan. Her Map is about organic waste its conversion to compost and its uses in growing vegetable garden.

**Dr. Mumtaz Akhtar (IER)** said that it was innovative, creative, informative and learning opportunity provided by ITA and it will enable her to transmit this learning and creativity to her colleagues and to students through teachers. Her MAP Title is Capacity Building regarding Green Technology as Alternative Energy will be implemented to the Students of

Class 10<sup>th</sup> and it will aim to enhance the knowledge of students regarding various forms of alternative energy.

**Neseem Naz (DSD)** shared her experiences of PSU regarding activity based learning in which she comprehend the idea of water pollution as it was conveyed through activity of coloured in sponge and plain sponge. She was inspired by this and develop her MAP which is Activity based learning for primary teachers. She will address primary teachers of her area as currently teachers have no idea of activity based learning. She will work on Atom, Molecule and Parts of Plants as these topic starts from primary and move on to higher classes. This will help her in her secondary teaching.

**Asifa Naz (PEF)** started from her hopes in pre departure and took the whole journey of the programme through pictures. The top of her Map is rubric as the best assessment practice. She will conduct this in PEF cluster schools and will share with the whole group.

**Hifza Zainab (DSD)** learned a hard lesson of “*time is money*” as she was left behind while she was only few minutes late to go for a field visit. She also emphasized that generally people there were very nice to them. Her MAP was teaching methodologies by using low cost and no cost material for primary and secondary level teachers in Government School.

**Dr. Zulfiqar (DSD)** said that he will help in environmental MAP.

**Mr. Tahir (WWF)** was pleased with all the learning and said that they will share the MAP implementation with all the others.

**Mr. Jawad (DSD)** thanked all the Participant and said that it was very informative and DSD will definitely benefit from MAP implementation and he asked the participants from other organizations to share their results.
